How do I get there?

By airplane: The closest airport to Lugano is Milano Malpensa (after that Milano Linate Airport). Most international (and budget) airlines fly to Milan.

By bus from Milano Malpensa to Lugano: The shuttle bus is the fastest and most affordable option, taking only 1hr and costing 40 CHF (around 35 euros) for a return ticket.

By bus from Milano Linate to Lugano: From Milano Linate you first need to take a shuttle bus to Milan Central, where you can take a train to Lugano (FFS).
